The date for the Entrance Tests for **Economics** and **English** will be announced after the publications of Class XII results of MBOSE.

B.SC. (Biotechnology)

Duration: A written test of 60 minutes duration.

Content:

- Students will be tested in the areas of Biology, Chemistry and Physics taught in the Higher Secondary level and Mathematics at the Secondary level.
- The test will have two sections:
 - Section A will have 40 Multiple Choice type questions.
 - Section B will have 20 Fill in the Blanks type questions.
- The weightage given in both sections, to the respective subject areas, will be in the ratio of 5:3:1:1.
- Negative marks will be awarded to incorrect answers.

Selection:

Candidates will be short-listed based on their performance in their entrance test. To be eligible for admission, candidates need to have an aggregate of 60% in their Higher Secondary Examinations.

Bachelor of Business Administration

Duration:The test will be of 1 hour 30 minutes' duration

Content:

- **The test will have five sections:**
 - Logical reasoning: This section will test the logical and analytical skills of the candidate.
 - Numerical ability: Mathematics up to the level of Class X.
 - English Usage and Comprehension.
 - Data interpretation and sufficiency.
 - General knowledge of current affairs

Selection:

Successful candidates must qualify in each of the sections. To be eligible for admission, the Candidate must be successful at the entrance test and secure a minimum aggregate of 55% at the qualifying Higher Secondary Examination. This is open for Arts/Commerce/Science students.

Bachelor of Computer Science

Duration: The test will be of 2 hours' duration

Content:

- **The test will have two sections:**
 - Section A (Logical Reasoning) will have 60% weightage. This section will test the logical and analytical skills of the candidate.

- Section B (Mathematics) will carry 40% weightage. The following topics from the Higher Secondary Mathematics syllabus will be induced for testing: Algebra, Boolean Algebra, Calculus and Coordinate Geometry.

Selection:

Successful candidates must qualify in each of the sections. To be eligible for admission, the Candidate must be successful at the entrance test and secure a minimum aggregate of 55% at the qualifying Higher Secondary Examination.

BA/BSC Economics

Duration: The test will be of 1 hour duration

Areas to be tested:

- Elementary knowledge of Economics applicable at the higher secondary level. Science students opting for this course are advised to consult any higher secondary Economics textbook.
- Mathematics aptitude at the Secondary Level.

Selection:

Candidates will be short-listed based on their performance in the entrance test. To be eligible for admission, the Candidate must be successful at the entrance test and secure a minimum aggregate of 55% at the qualifying Higher Secondary Examination.

BA (Mass Communication and Video Production)

Duration: The test will be of 2 hours' duration

Content:

- Writing skills, Audio and Visual Comprehension in the area of the electronic media.
- A special focus on Grammar and Syntax Structuring.
- General knowledge in the areas of current affairs, art and culture, film and literature.

Selection:

Candidates will be short-listed based on their performance in the entrance test. To be eligible for admission, the Candidate must be successful at the entrance test and secure a minimum aggregate of 55% at the qualifying Higher Secondary Examination. This is open for Arts/Commerce/Science students.

BA (MEDIA TECHNOLOGIES)

Duration: The test will be of 2 hours duration.

Content:

- Audio and Visual Comprehension in the area of print journalism, Audio production and photography.
- A special focus in Grammar and Syntax Structuring
- General Knowledge in the current affairs, Arts and Culture, Film and Literature
- Writing skills

Selection:

Candidates will be shortlisted based on their performance in this test. To be eligible for admission, the candidate needs to have an aggregate of 55% in the Higher Secondary Examination. This is open for students of Arts/ Commerce/ Science.

BA MUSIC

The test for Music will be an Aptitude Test.

Areas to be tested:

- Sense of tonality
- Acquaintance with Indian style of singing
- Fluency in playing instruments such as keyboard, guitar, etc.. A Graded certificate will be an advantage.
- General awareness about Music, Musicians (Indian and Western), Music of the North East.

Selection:

Candidates will be shortlisted based on their performance in this test. To be eligible for admission, the candidate needs to have an aggregate of 55% in the Higher Secondary Examination. This is open for students of Arts/ Commerce/ Science.
